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#### **Insurance Certificate Documentation Information**

The HPAC/ACVL requires that the issuing of any insurance certificate documentation must comply with the following guidelines:

Any site, location, and all events where insurance has been provided by the HPAC/ACVL, requires that all individuals participating at the site, location or event:

- a) be insured members of the HPAC/ACVL and
- b) have signed the HPAC Waiver.

The HPAC/ACVL expects that a reasonable effort will be made by the applicant to ensure compliance with these guidelines.

Insurance Certificates will only be issued upon receipt of the completed application (previous page).

#### **SPECIAL EVENT REQUIREMENTS**

Competition or Fly-In organizers must ensure that

- a) An Order Respecting Special Aviation Events Safety (or an exemption to the Order) is applied for
- b) where applicable, a NOTAM is applied for
- c) where applicable that competitors (or the organizer) file a "HAGAR" Cross Country notification to the nearest Flight Information Centre (FIC).

Certificate Fees: There are no fees associated with Site and Special Event Certificates
